

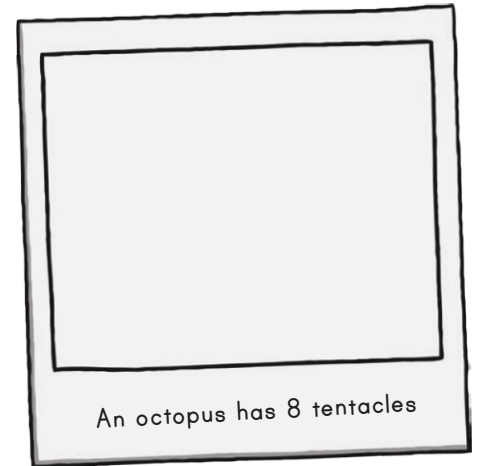
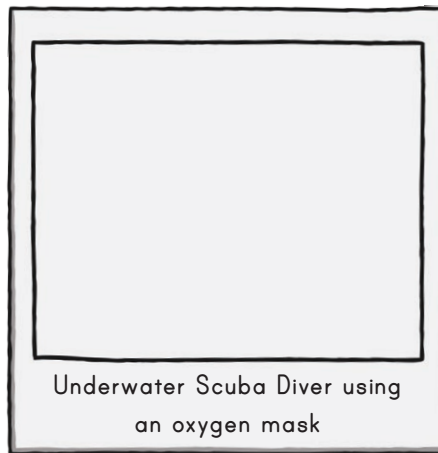
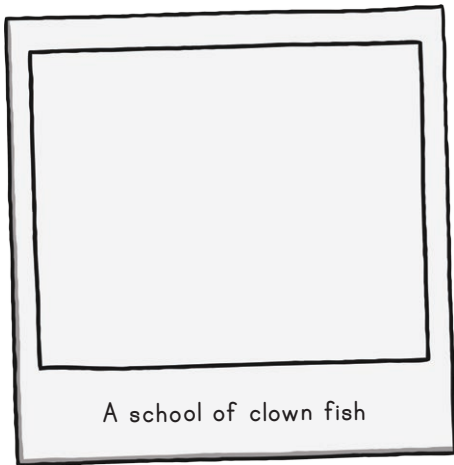


# Illustrate the Caption
