Potential themes for your stories:

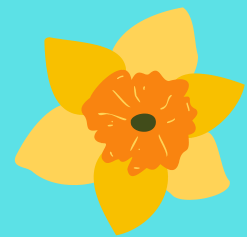
- A story about a haunted castle

- Clap, clap 123

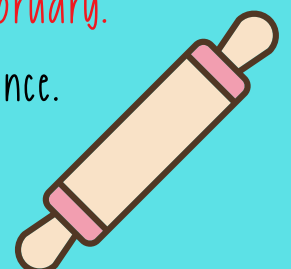


Cooking competition

Story telling competition

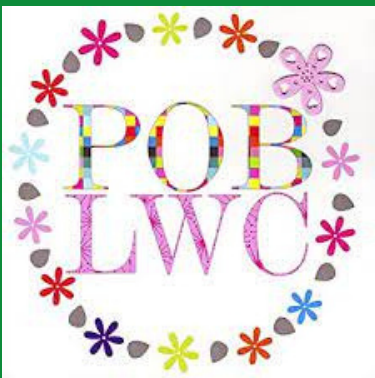
Retell a traditional Welsh tale in a creative way, you can retell your story individually or in small groups (max 5 people). You could retell the story through:
